APPELLANT MOTION TO STAY ORDER

Appellant ask the Court to Grant Stay the attached Order of Judge Maite Murphy from the Richland County Court until a hearing is heard by the Appeals Court.

Appellant did not receive a review or decision of his file Motions and other actions that was filed was filed against the Defendants, resulting in an inability to properly process his case.

During the Motion Roster Hearing of June 27, 2023, Judge Murphy told Appellant not to not submit any Proposed Orders that she would represent that actions on Appellant's

behalf and write the proposed Orders. The Court did not review or comment on any of Appellant's pending actions but responded to Defendant's Attorney Motions and responses.

Defendant Attorneys submitted Proposed Orders without providing Appellant copies as required by Rules of SCRPC.

The Court amended the Complaint to delete Claire H. Eckert and Chick-Fil-A, Inc., based solely on Defendants Proposed Order.

Plaintiff maintains that Claire H. Eckert, Chick-Fil-A, Inc., 2CE LLC, and Christ M. Eckert are proper Defendants in this suite. Ms. Eckert is the owner, as verified by the Columbia Police incident report of June 17, 2022, of the 2019 Honda that displayed the Chick-Fil-A image/logo the employee delivery driver Sasha N. Gray drove when she collided with Appellant's parked vehicle resulting in injury.

Defendant admitted in discovery that Arch Insurance Company is the same insurance company that insures the Chick-Fil-A Restaurant, insures the 2019 Honda vehicle.


It is of information and belief that Ms. Eckert owns a fleet (multiply vehicle) of Chick-Fil-A branded delivery vehicles for the restaurant.


