I.

The Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter are due to the Court today, August 18, 2023, pursuant to two previous extensions granted by the Court.

II.

Pursuant to RE: Extension Requests in Criminal Direct Appeals and Post-Conviction Relief Certiorari Proceedings: Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009, the Respondent moves for a third extension in the above referenced appeal. Due to work required in other cases pending before this Court, the Supreme Court, and the Circuit Courts, I am unable to complete this Brief on time. In the 30 days since the last extension was granted in this matter, the undersigned counsel has filed a Petition For Rehearing in Mack Washington v. State (2018-000182), a Brief of Respondent in State v. Adam Rowell (2022-000571), Initial Briefs Of Respondent and Designations Of Matter in State v. Andres Fernando Posso (2022-001396) and State v. Angel Misael Ibarra

(2022-000774), and a Return To Petition For Writ Of Certiorari and Brief of Respondent Pursuant To White v. State in Markese East v. State (2022-000557), a proposed order from a remand hearing held in Greenwood County in State v. Terrence O’Neil Frazier (Indictment Nos. 2015-GS-24-1603, -1604, -1605, -1606, -1632) (2015-002464) and a proposed Order of Dismissal in Lawton L. Holloway v. State (2022-CP-42-04266). I would therefore request an extension of time within which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter.

This extension request is not intended for purposes of delay, but rather to ensure that the Brief is properly researched and prepared.

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that the Court extend the deadline for the service and filing of the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter in this case for thirty (30) days; and for such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.


