

MOTION FOR COSTS ON APPEAL

Respondents, BGF Industries and Great American Alliance Insurance Co., the prevailing parties, by and through their undersigned attorney, hereby move the Court pursuant to Rules 222 and 242, SCACR, for costs in the amount of \$5,688.59 as set forth on the attached Itemized Statement of Costs.
