ORDER

After careful consideration, Respondent South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce's motion to dismiss is granted. On April 12, 2023, this court issued an order striking Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter for failure to comply with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules and requiring her to serve and file an amended initial brief and designation of matter within thirty days. Appellant failed to comply. On May 23, 2023, this court sent Appellant a letter providing her another ten days in which to serve and file the amended documents and warning that failure to comply would result in dismissal of the appeal. On May 30, 2023, Appellant filed an initial brief and designation of matter identical to those that this court previously reviewed and struck in its April 12, 2023. Because Appellant has failed to comply with this court's order and letter, this appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
