SUPPORTING EVIDENCE

1. On August 18th, 2023 the Court of Appeals Judiciary has responded to the Petitioners Writ of Mandamus and the plea for the Supreme Court to guarantee, and protect the Petitioners Protected right to appeal a Criminal case according to the court rules, and laws of South Carolina.
2. The Court of Appeals response to the serious claims of the Petitioner was not to follow the law, or the rules set in place on the matter, rather they (Appellate judges) decided to commit felonies, and conspire to further not only denied a protected right of a citizen, but to cover up despicable of fellow lower court Judges Diana Goodstein and Jeffery Bloom.
3. In other words, Both Jeffery Bloom, and Diana Goodstein are so criminally incompetent they have failed to manage the basic functions of protection of civil rights, and rather deny such protections in a conspiracy. Once this case is appealed the panel of 8 other judges that represent the highest form of justice have also engulfed their own reputation into the "COVER-UP" of unlawful acts by the South Carolina Judiciary.
4. On August 18, 2023 the Judges on the matter have entered an Order to rather dismiss this case without rebuttal to the Writ of Mandamus, and the Constitutional challenges of the Petitioner. This Order claims that the appeal is a "CIVIL" matter, forcing the Petitioner to pay filing fees, and transcript fees.

5. This Order denies the Petitioner the Protection to person, and property which is the duty of the court, and the court knowingly, persistently denies, and withholds such protections when within its power, releases them from the obligation of obedience...
6. When a court acts without jurisdiction, it is the usurpation of a power, and its proceedings are VOID, when a court has jurisdiction, but acts WRONGFULLY, it is an error in judgement, and its proceedings are only voidable Hunt's Heir's vs Edison's Heir's 32Alb. 193.



MOTION

7. The Petitioner Motions the Supreme Court to void, or dismiss this Order pertaining to the civil rights, and the process in protection of the state Constitution, and federally protected rights of the petitioner. This motion should be considered an attack in the mode directed by law while in proceeding;
8. This is also opportunity to conclude the Petitioners original argument, and stance in the lower court that the civil traffic infractions were not criminal, and rather civil in nature, and subject matter jurisdiction. The Order of the Court of Appeals has further ruled such in their ruling on August 18, 2023, and further ruling the Calhoun County Sherriff's Department, and Orangeburg County Detention Center, and Orangeburg County Municipality are Civilly liable for False arrest, False Imprisonment, and Malicious Prosecution.
9. The Petitioners seeks immediate intervention as the damages are ongoing. And though the Accused judges get judicial immunity, and are allowed to violate civil rights without regard, or reproach the petitioner motions this court to void both Jeffery Bloom, and Diana Goodstein's orders on the matter, as a matter of law.

OBJECTIONS

10. The Petitioner objects to the August 18 2023 order case No. 2023-000409 of the court of appeals as it's a violation of my protected right, the denial of due process, and in conflict of official duties of court officers who are subject to the states Tort Claims Act, refusing to properly perform clerk duties are felonies, and these actions are documented fact of the felonies performed on the court of record.
11. I may be pro se, but Catherine Harrison Deputy clerk is in direct conflict with the law, and my civil rights, this case is criminal not civil, no court rule can disregard my right for redress, and I filed a copy of the material facts needed to prove this claim.
12. Jeffery Bloom signed and dated the materials (Exhibits) and Diana Goodstein signed off on his criminal behavior, that is if you deem this case CIVIL, you also deem both Jeffery Bloom, and Diana Goodstein criminals as a matter of law. The Petitioner will now move in state court against state officials who are in conflict with the state and federal constitutions, and make State Tort claims in this matter, heck lets involve the whole damn judiciary, media, congress persons, and senators, I have no issues with that, I have nothing to hide, I just want my rights, and my justice, I care less if you want to throw away careers to violate civil rights.




