Mr. Safran, I am in receipt of your letter of June 24, 2013, wherein you have requested a transcript of the hearing in Richland County before Judge Cooper on March 6, 2013.

Please be advised that transcript fees are promulgated by SCACR Rule 607, which can be found at the following link:

I estimate that the transcript will consist of approximately 50 pages. Therefore, I will require an advance deposit of \$160 to place your request in line for transcription, sent to me at the address listed below. If the final cost exceeds this amount, I will contact you for additional payment before the transcript is finalized. Similarly, if the final cost is less than the deposit amount, I will refund the overage to you.

Additionally, please further define your request in terms of transcript format (paper copy via U.S. Mail, electronic copy via e-mail, etc.) and how soon you would like to have the transcript, as there are additional fees for expedited transcripts and other services as set forth in SCACR Rule 607(h)(1)(J). Specifically, there are two different expedited rates; therefore, I will need to know which turnaround time you are seeking. One rate is for one-day expedited preparation; the other, for seven-day. If you do not specify a turnaround time, your request will be processed at the

normal turnaround rate of 60 days.

In accordance with the court reporter manual approved by the Supreme Court of South Carolina, the due date will be determined by the date I receive your advance payment.

Please let me know if you have any questions or need additional information, and I will await your further advisement.
