Counsel filed the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Micah Brown with this Court on June 30, 2023. Counsel filed the Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Brandon Johnson with this Court on June 19, 2023. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Randall Gadson v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 9, 2023.






