

ORDER

On August 21, 2023, Appellant sent an email to this court stating, "I need to file a motion to waive all costs, as I can't afford the filing fee." On August 29, 2023, Appellant sent a letter to this court "requesting that the motion filing fee please be waived." We construe these two documents as a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Appellant has not met her burden of establishing she has a statutory or constitutional right to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Accordingly, the motion is denied. *See Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order. Failure to provide the filing fee may result in the dismissal of this appeal.
