At a Court of General Sessions, convened on February 14, 2022, the Grand Jurors of Cherokee County present upon their oath:


**ATTEMPTED MURDER-COUNT ONE**

That Timmy Lee Douglas did in Cherokee County on or about August 18, 2021, with malice aforethought either expressed or implied, attempt to kill [REDACTED] by shooting the victim, with the intent to kill the victim, in violation of §16-03-029, OF THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, (1976, as amended).

**POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING  
COMMISSION OF A VIOLENT CRIME-COUNT TWO**

That Timmy Lee Douglas did in Cherokee County on or about August 18, 2021, possess a firearm during the commission of a violent crime as defined in Code §16-1-60, to wit: Attempted Murder, in violation of Code §16-23-490, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, (1976), as amended.
