

ORDER

On June 13, 2023, this court ordered Appellant to serve and file an amended record on appeal containing all matters Respondent designated for inclusion in the record. On August 14, 2023, Appellant filed an amended record on appeal that failed to comply with this court's order.¹ Therefore, we dismiss the appeal. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209 and shall comply with the requirements of Rule 267."); Rule 260(a), SCACR ("Whenever it appears that an appellant or a

¹ This is the latest in a series of orders addressing Appellant's failure to file a record on appeal that complies with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. On March 23, 2023, this court granted Respondent's first motion to strike and ordered Appellant to serve and file an amended record containing all of Respondent's designated matters. This order further instructed Appellant to file the amended record in compliance with Rule 210(c), SCACR, and specified that the amended record must not include documents not presented to the lower court. Appellant filed an amended record, and on May 5, 2023, Respondents moved to dismiss the appeal or, in the alternative, to strike because the amended record again failed to include all of Respondent's designated matters and again included matters not presented to the lower court. On June 13, 2023, the court declined to dismiss the appeal, but again ordered Appellant to file a rules-compliant record. The current order addresses Respondent's August 21, 2023 motion to dismiss the appeal.
