**MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF SENTENCE  
WITH RESPECT TO PROVISION OF JAIL CREDITS**

On July 20, 2023, the Defendant was convicted and sentenced on the above-referenced indictment/warrants. In accordance with said sentencing the Court determined that Defendant should be granted credit for a certain amount of jail days served. Counsel for Defendant has since had an opportunity to better review Defendant's records, and Counsel submits that Defendant is entitled to more jail days than what was afforded. Counsel for Defendant submits that the correct amount of jail days to which Defendant is entitled is 1962 days.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant requests that the Sentencing Orders be amended to reflect that Defendant is entitled to credit for 1962 days served towards his sentence.






