

## ORDER

By order dated February 2, 2013, the South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal in this matter based on petitioner's failure to pay the filing fee required by Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). The Court of Appeals subsequently denied a petition for reinstatement/reconsideration on April 30, 2013. When no petition for a writ of certiorari had been filed with this Court in the time specified by Rule 242(c), SCACR, the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur on June 17, 2013. *Bryan v. SCDC*, Appellate Case No. 2012-213194.

This Court has now received a petition for a writ of certiorari dated June 24, 2013. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007). Accordingly, the petition for a writ of certiorari is dismissed.
