3. Violation of my 6th Amendment, Entitled effective assistance of counsel for defence.


Facts

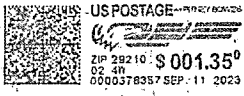
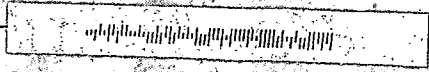
