RESPONSE AND REQUEST FOR BEMAND TO  
TRIAL COURT FOR EVIDENTIARY HEARING  
DUE TO MULTIPLE CIVIL RIGHTS VIOLATIONS

- 1) On 9/12/22 a hearing was conducted before Richland County (RC) Circuit Court Judge Clifton Newman who relieved Lir Patrick Derieg as Appellant's court appointed attorney with the STIPULATION, on the record, that Defendant have stand by counsel from the RC Public Defenders Office.
- 2) The proposed Order Lir Patrick Derieg emailed on 9/16/22 to Appellant and former prosecuting attorney Steven Jordan (no relation) who is NO longer with South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce did NOT contain stand by counsel from the RC Public Defenders Office.
- 3) The RC Clerk of Courts Roster posted online for 11/9/23 trials showed Appellant's case first up before Judge Curtis while Judge Hood was scheduled for Motions Hearings at 2:00pm with two different Defendants.
- 4) Judge Hood emailed Appellant over the weekend and stated HE would be trying the case at 2:00pm

on 11/9/23.

5) On 11/7/23 at 4:55pm when Appellant got a certificate of service clocked in at the BC Clerk of Courts office, employee Jharan (didn't give last name) gave Appellant a copy of Judge Clifton Newman's order dated 9/17/22, she knew had NOT been mailed, which DID include the BC Public Defenders' office appointing stand by counsel. No copy fee was charged due to their error.

6) The BC Clerk of Court obstructed justice by withholding Judge Newman's Order dated 9/17/22 until 11/7/23 AFTER Appellant's case had been tried.

7) The BC Clerk of Court obstructed justice by publishing Appellant's case being tried FIRST before Judge Curtis on 11/9/23 instead of at 2:00pm before Judge Hood. The BC Public Defenders' office would have had stand by counsel at 9:00am in Judge Curtis's courtroom and NOBODY from the BC Public Defenders' office showed up at Appellant's trial because the change was NOT published on 11/9/23 as verified by Appellant's emails to the Judges and copies of the Court Rosters posted on 11/9/23.

8) On 11/9/23 Appellant went to BC Public Defender Jennifer Davis's office before having to surrender a six year old Chihuahua to Pawmetta Lifeline because I had nobody to take care of him while I served a one year prison sentence.

③

Instead of having me file a Motion for a New Trial within the ten day period, Jennifer Davis had me sign the paper work for APPEAL which now cannot be withdrawn WITHOUT prejudice. My dog was adopted by someone else, I cannot get him back.

9) On 4/18/23 Appellant mailed a Motion to Overturn Conviction and Remand to Municipal Court for Preliminary Hearing Based on Newly Discovered Evidence and Petition for Hearing En Banc. Appellant did NOT receive the requested hearing En Banc, instead received an Order filed 6/21/23 signed by only ONE Judge which is a civil rights violation.

10) Appellant respectfully requests that the South Carolina Court of Appeals (SCCOA) remand the case to the trial Court for an Evidentiary Hearing, where the RC Public Defender's Office would provide stand by counsel.

11) If the SCCOA retains jurisdiction Appellant respectfully requests to be Pro Se with the Division of Appellate Defense as stand by counsel, since stand by counsel was ordered by Judge Newman but DENIED to Appellant in the original trial because the RC Clerk of Court obstructed justice by withholding Judge Newman's Order from Appellant and CONCEALING Appellant's trial from the RC Public Defender's office.

- 12) Appellant respectfully requests a Hearing En Banc.
- 13) Appellant respectfully requests an extension of time to order trial transcript based on cause.
- 14) Following the example posted online by Richard Alexander Murdaugh's attorneys, Appellant plans to hand deliver a request for Federal Investigation into civil rights violations to US Attorney Adair Ford Burroughs, 1441 Main Street Suite 500, Columbia, SC 29201.

They can certainly contact us if needed but we will not release any information regarding the family that has adopted him. They have a right to privacy. I will be more than happy to acknowledge that you reached out to see if Oreo had been adopted and your interest in getting him back.
