2. Counsel will file the initial brief of appellant in the case of State v. Sosa Croft with the Court of Appeals today, September 22, 2023. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Eric Harper v. State with the Supreme Court


on September 6, 2023. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of William T. Smith v. State with the Supreme Court on August 23, 2023. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Sidney Stclair Moorner with the Supreme Court on August 18, 2023. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Jaylen Bell with the Court of Appeals on August 14, 2023. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. David Hayden with the Court of Appeals on July 24, 2023. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Quayshaun X. Clark with the Court of Appeals on July 14, 2023.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




