MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Jefferson via WebEx for reconstruction hearings in the cases of The State v. Marvin Donte Bryan and Breon Alexandre v. The State on August 8, 2023.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. On September 1, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through September 30.
