

ORDER

Appellant has filed a petition to stay the circuit court's September 11, 2023 order dismissing her appeal of the magistrate's writ of ejection. After careful consideration, the petition to stay is temporarily granted pending (1) this court's receipt and review of a return to the petition, and (2) this court's receipt and review of a signed undertaking pursuant to section 27-40-800 of the South Carolina Code. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 27-40-800(f)(1) (2007) ("Upon appeal to the Supreme Court or to the court of appeals, it is sufficient to stay execution of a judgment for ejection that the tenant sign an undertaking that he will pay to the landlord the amount of rent, determined by order of the judge of the circuit court, as it becomes due periodically after judgment was entered. The judge of the court having jurisdiction shall order stay of execution upon the undertaking."). Respondent's return and Appellant's signed undertaking shall be served and filed within ten days of the date of this order.
