In the explanation required by Rule 243(c), SCACR, Petitioner has failed to show there is an arguable basis for asserting the determination of the lower court was improper. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.

Further, we hereby prohibit Petitioner from filing any further collateral actions in the circuit court, including post-conviction relief actions and habeas corpus actions, as well as any motions relating to previously filed collateral actions, challenging Petitioner's conviction and sentence for murder (indictment number 1995-GS-12-00226), or any motions in the underlying criminal case, including a motion pursuant to Rule 29, SCRCrimP, without first obtaining permission to do so from this Court.
