Pursuant to correspondence from The South Carolina Court of Appeals dated February 23, 2012, I am providing a written update regarding the status of this matter. The parties have engaged in extensive settlement negotiations in an effort to resolve all outstanding issues in dispute. Appellants respectfully request an additional 60 days to obtain additional information necessary to settlement of the claim. Specifically, Appellants have endeavored to obtain a Medicare Set-aside to properly protect the federal government's interests with regard to a final settlement of Ms. Moser's future medical benefits. Appellants believe that a 60 day extension will afford the parties sufficient time to settle the claim and eliminate the need for further pursuit of this appeal.
