

## ORDER

---

On May 11, 2023, Appellant filed a motion to relieve her counsel, Timothy Kirk Truslow, Esquire. This court warned Appellant of the dangers of self-representation by an order dated August 23, 2023. The order requested Appellant inform this court within thirty days if she wanted to proceed pro se despite the dangers of self-representation. On September 20, 2023, Appellant filed a "notice of representation," stating she wants to represent herself. After careful consideration, we grant Appellant's motion to relieve Attorney Truslow. Further, we find Appellant understands the dangers of self-representation and makes the decision to proceed pro se knowingly, voluntarily, and intelligently. Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter are due within thirty days of the date of this order.
