## ORDER

On August 21, 2023, Appellant filed a motion to amend his initial and final briefs due to the briefs including information related to his age later determined to be incorrect. Specifically, the court reporter erred by attributing to the solicitor that Appellant was sixteen years of age. Appellant filed his initial brief relying upon this statement. However, upon a challenge made by Respondent, the court reporter issued a correction to reflect the solicitor referred to Appellant as eighteen years old. In its return, Respondent opposed the request to amend. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's request to amend his initial and final briefs. We note Appellant's final brief includes multiple footnotes explaining the transcription error.
