

ORDER

On August 21, 2023, Respondents moved to strike a portion of page 809 of the record on appeal. Specifically, Respondents moved to strike lines thirteen through twenty from page twenty of Jordan Harper's deposition transcript because "those lines were not actually presented to the lower court or tribunal" Appellant filed a return, opposing the motion to strike and moving this court to require that Respondents pay Appellant's attorney's fees and costs incurred by defending the motion to strike. Respondents filed a reply. After careful consideration, we grant Respondents' motion to strike lines thirteen through twenty from page 809 of the record on appeal. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR (explaining the record on appeal "shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal"). We order Appellant to file and serve an amended record on appeal – volume II. Further, we deny Appellant's motion for attorneys' fees and costs. *See* Rule 269, SCACR (allowing an appellate court to impose sanctions upon a party who files a frivolous motion).
