Counsel for Quinton Maurice Collins respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension from October 5, 2023 until November 6, 2023, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of The State v. Anthony Markale Porterfield with the Supreme Court on September 25, 2023. Counsel filed


the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Shemual N. Yisrael with the Court of Appeals on August 30, 2023. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Derrick A. McIlwain with the Court of Appeals on August 24, 2023. Counsel submitted a proposed order to Judge Eugene C. Griffith in the remand case of The State v. Terrence O'Neil Frazier on August 15, 2023. Counsel appeared before the Honorable Deadra L. Jefferson via WebEx for reconstruction hearings in the cases of The State v. Marvin Donte Bryan and Breon Alexandre v. The State on August 8, 2023.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. On October 3, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through October 31.


