Dear Ms. Howard:

I am counsel for Clark Equipment Company, which is a Respondent in the above-referenced case, although it has been incorrectly named as “Bobcat Company, Inc.” This letter is to notify the Clerk of Court regarding this clerical issue about the correct identification of Clark Equipment Company as a party. We raised this clerical issue both in the Circuit Court and in the Court of Appeals, but it has lingered up to and including the Court of Appeals’ opinion (in footnote 1), and we simply want to be sure the Supreme Court’s records accurately reflect the identification of the parties. The correct real party in interest is Clark Equipment Company, doing business as Bobcat Company. My understanding is there is no actual legal entity called “Bobcat Company, Inc.” (at least not a legal entity related to the parties to this case).

In addition, we note that both Bobcat of Greenville, LLC, and the incorrectly-named Bobcat Company, Inc. have been listed as “Petitioners-Respondents,” although Clark Equipment Company (regardless of how it is named) has not actually submitted a Petition.

I do not know if any change is needed at this time, so this letter is simply to call these clerical matters to the Clerk’s attention. If any action is needed from Clark Equipment Company or if we may provide further information on this clerical issue, we will be happy to assist.
