
Pursuant to Rules 208(a)(3) and 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellant Bank of America, N.A., successor by merger to BAC Home Loans Servicing, LP FKA Countrywide Home Loans Servicing, LP (“Bank of America”), requests a ten (10) day extension of time to file its Initial Reply Brief and in the above-captioned matter. This will be Bank of America’s **final request** for an extension of this deadline.

This request is necessitated due to an extraordinary circumstance that prevented undersigned counsel from completing Bank of America’s Reply Brief within the current deadline. Undersigned counsel has been out of the office due to a recent surgery. This time out of the office has placed a burden on counsel’s case load and other briefing deadlines and will not allow him to complete the Reply Brief within the current deadline. This extension will allow counsel time to complete Bank of America’s Reply Brief in this matter. Currently, Bank of America’s Initial Reply Brief is due on July 22, 2013.¹ With the additional ten (10) day extension, Bank of America’s Initial Reply Brief will be due August 1, 2013, per Rule 263, SCACR.

Therefore, Bank of America respectfully moves this Court for a ten (10) day extension of time to file its Initial Reply Brief in the above-captioned matter until August 1, 2013. Undersigned counsel thanks the Court for its consideration of this request. Bank of America asks that the current deadline be held in abeyance pending the Court’s consideration and resolution of this motion.

¹ On July 10, 2013, this Court issued an order granting Bank of America a “ten-day extension to serve and file Appellant’s initial reply brief.” Bank of America calculated the current deadline from the date of the order because no due date was set forth in the order.
