

INDICTMENT FOR

Murder / Possession of a Weapon during the
Commission of a Violent Crime

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on July 30, 2020 the Grand Jurors of
SUMTER County present upon their oath:

COUNT ONE - MURDER

That Diontrae Travon Epps did in Sumter County, on or about September 8, 2019, willfully, feloniously, and intentionally kill the victim, Michael Rogers, with malice aforethought, either express or implied, by means of shooting the victim with a handgun, and the victim did die as a proximate result thereof, in violation of Section 16-03-0010, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT TWO-POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING A VIOLENT CRIME

That Diontrae Travon Epps did in Sumter County, on or about September 8, 2019, possess a firearm, or visibly display what appeared to be a firearm, or visibly displayed a knife, during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime, in violation of Section 16-23-0490, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
