1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today.

On Monday, May 6, 2013, counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Travell Hill. On Wednesday, May 1, 2013, counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Jacqueline Yvette Sullivan, and the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Johnny Frazier v. 


