

ORDER

On September 27, 2023, Appellant filed a motion to relieve counsel and appoint new counsel. Appellant's counsel did not file a return. After careful consideration, Appellant's motion is denied. *See State v. Roberts*, 364 S.C. 583, 588–89, 614 S.E.2d 626, 629 (2005) ("Appellant clearly does not have a federal constitutional right to proceed pro se in this appeal from his criminal conviction. We also find there is no state constitutional provision which confers such a right); *id.* at 589, 614 S.E.2d at 629 ("Moreover, appellate counsel has no duty to raise every non-frivolous issue presented by the record and must be allowed to exercise reasonable professional judgment.").
