Good morning,

My name is Angeline Larrivee, and I have recently resigned from Poulin | Willey | Anastopoulo, LLC. When I left, I was counsel of record on eight cases with this Court (specifically, 2019-001943; 2020-000534; 2021-001304; 2022-001162; 2022-001385; 2023-000143; 2023-000718; 2023-001431). Of course, I no longer have access to those case files and can no longer work on the cases.

Consequently, I sent letters requesting relief to this Court as to several of those cases. However, each response I have received thus far has informed me that I need to file a motion and pay a \$50 filing fee. As I am presently unemployed, that is rather a steep requirement.
