

EXPLANATION OF APPEAL

Michael Gregory Youman appeals his sentence in the aforementioned case. The defendant was summoned to a probation violation hearing after a new arrest for Domestic Violence High and Aggravated Nature. He had not yet been convicted on this new charge by either plea or trial. Judge Taylor found it to be a willful violation and revoked his current probationary sentence in full, 3 years. Mr. Youman maintains his innocence and wishes to appeal his sentence.





Hearing Officer's Findings:

I find that Michael Geggory Youman violated conditions 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, and SCDPPPS Domestic Violence Conditions as set forth in the affidavit(s) dated July 24, 2023; such conditions having been contained in the Order of Probation accepted by Michael Geggory Youman in writing on January 12, 2023.

I find that Michael Geggory Youman failed to refrain from the possession or purchase of any firearm or other dangerous weapons; and associate with any person who has a criminal record, or any person whom my Agent has instructed to avoid. Mr. Youman failed to refrain from the possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon. As evidenced by Orangeburg County Sheriff's Office Incident Report 2023-0001004; on January 26, 2023, Mr. Youman was noted to have been in possession of a firearm having pointed it at the victim during a domestic disturbance while at the address of 113 Rapp Lane in Springfield, South Carolina.

I find that Michael Geggory Youman failed to refrain from the violation of Federal, State, or Local Law; and to immediately contact the Agent when arrested or questioned by a law enforcement official for any reason whatsoever. Mr. Youman failed to refrain from and notify his agent thereof, the following violation of Federal, State, of Local Law. As evidenced by Orangeburg County Sheriff's Office Incident Report 2023-0001004 dated January 26, 2023; Mr. Youman committed the criminal offense of Domestic Violence 1st Degree. Officers responded to the address of 113 Rapp Lane in Springfield, SC in reference to a domestic disturbance. Upon arrival, officers met with the victim/complainant Khadijah Clifton; Ms. Clifton noted to officers that her boyfriend, Michael Youman, had pointed a firearm at herself while in the presence of her son. Ms. Clifton noted that she and Mr. Youman were arguing in the kitchen when Mr. Youman became upset then pointed a firearm at her, threatened to do her harm, then fled the residence. Ms. Clifton then noted that she recorded the interaction, playing the recording which, they could hear Mr. Youman's making the comment of "Ill blow your fucking head off" and "I will put this bitch on your ass". Officers had Ms. Clifton fill out a victim's statement and contacted the local

Orangeburg County Victims Advocate about potential safe housing arrangements; Ms. Clifton however, deciding that she did not want that service as she wished to stay with her mother. Officers determined Mr. Youman to be the primary aggressor to which warrant was sort for Domestic Violence 1st Degree. Mr. Youman then being arrested at a later date.

I find that Michael Geggory Youman failed to pay supervision fee and other fees as determined by the Department. Mr. Youman was \$300.00 in arrears on his Regular Supervision Fee Account and \$20.00 in arrears on his Drug Test Fee Account at the issuance of legal process.

I find that Michael Geggory Youman failed to pay fines, restitution or other payments, and the service of any period of incarceration. Mr. Youman was \$162.92 in arrears on his Court Ordered Fine Account at the issuance of legal process.

I find that the aforementioned violations constitute a willful failure to follow the advice and instructions of the supervising agent. I base these findings on the evidence and testimony presented at the Administrative Hearing.

Hearing Officer's Conclusions:

Its concluded that Mr. Youman failed to adhere to the terms of his supervision agreement. Per testimony from his agent, along with failing to pay on his financial obligations; Mr. Youman's actions continued to demonstrate that he is not willing to comply with his conditions of supervision. Mr. Youman has continued to have law enforcement contact; he is already under supervision for a domestic violence conviction and now has new assault/domestic violence charges with the same victim, Khadijah Clifton. As evidenced by Orangeburg County Sheriff's Office Incident Report 2023-0001004 dated January 26, 2023; Mr. Youman was at the residence with Ms. Clifton when an altercation occurred. Upon arrival, officers met with the victim/complainant Khadijah Clifton; Ms. Clifton noted to officers that her boyfriend, Michael Youman, had pointed a firearm at herself while in the presence of her son. Ms. Clifton noted that she and Mr. Youman were arguing in the kitchen when Mr. Youman became upset then pointed a firearm at her and then threatened to do her harm. Ms. Clifton noted that Mr. Youman had fled the residence before the arrival of law enforcement. Ms. Clifton then noted that she recorded the interaction, playing the recording which, they could hear Mr. Youman's making the comment of "Ill blow your fucking head off" and "I will put this bitch on your ass". Officers determined Mr. Youman to be the primary aggressor to which warrant was sort for Domestic Violence 1st Degree. Mr. Youman then being arrested at a later date. During the Administrative Hearing, Mr. Youman noted that the listed violations are not correct. Mr. Youman noted that an argument with Ms. Clifton did occur but not physical altercation ever did. Mr. Youman noted that he did not pull out any firearm as listed in the report and that he has been seeking legal counsel to address his pending criminal charges and that he wants to address his probation violations and new domestic violence charges at the same time. Domestic violence is deemed by the Department as a serious threat to community safety and such actions show that Mr. Youman has demonstrated behavior that is not in compliance with his supervision conditions. Case must be forwarded to S.C. General
