number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



From October 9, 2023 through October 11, 2023, counsel attended the Annual Public Defender Conference. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari, Brief of Appellant Pursuant to White v. State, and the Appendix in the case of Brian Foster v. State with the Supreme Court on October 3, 2023. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Raphael L. Pontoo v. The State with the Court of Appeals on September 18, 2023. Counsel filed the Return to the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Carmie Josette Nelson with the Supreme Court on September 8, 2023. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Narkevious M. Reid with the Court of Appeals on September 6, 2023.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
