
Dear Mr. Shearouse:

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the aforementioned matter are due to be served and filed today. I would respectfully request a fourth and final 30-day extension in which to serve and file the Petition and Appendix. This request is not intended for the purpose of delay. 
