Good morning,

Please do not file what I've sent you on this matter yet because I'm perfecting the pleading and attaching evidence for you this morning.

Once I had calmed down over the weekend, I noticed I had made several errors, including but not limited to seeming insinuations that unrelated parties supported or didn't support something I said because they were mentioned. I'm trying to make it so that I can tell my story about what happened without everyone getting mad or having claims against me once I am able to recover some or all of my losses.

I plan on also attaching a financial pleading for help with costs and a lawsuit against LKQ Scrapyard which coincides with the matters mentioned in my appeal draft.

I apologize that I was emotionally "triggered" and didn't realize the inadvertent insinuations that were made in Friday's draft while rushing to try getting you something to keep my case open prior to midnight. I haven't spoken to Attorney Dodds, for example. I know about the Water's Edge case because of research and don't want him to feel included in any way other than prior evidence of my opponent's deceptive behavior.

I also believe I may have said "State's Attorney" instead of "County Attorney" in another area. Please give me the morning to proof and repair this and attach everything to the extent inadvertent false statements are not made/filed by me against any person. My statement about the participation of that lawyer relative to my family and our interests, I believe, is accurate. There are just a lot of participants, so I got the wrong title in the draft because I am overwhelmed. I'm very sorry. I will replace the pleading today.
