
Dear Mr. Shearhouse:

I am in receipt of Mr. Widener's letter dated June 14, 2012, advising that Appellants will not file a Return to Respondents' Petition unless requested by this Court. The letter also states that Appellants do not object to a remand as requested by Respondents if the Petition for Rehearing is denied "provided the remand includes Appellants' claims against Respondents for their use and possession of the home." Should the Court deny Respondent's request for rehearing, the case should be remanded pursuant to the parties' stipulation at trial, not pursuant to the terms set forth in Appellants' June 14, 2012 letter to the Court.
