MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Robert Lee Moore respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from October 25, 2023 until November 24, 2023** in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Robert Lee Moore respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel attended the Annual South Carolina Public Defender Conference from October 9, 2023 until October 11, 2023. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of The State v. Anthony Markale Porterfield with the Supreme Court on September 25, 2023. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Shemual N. Yisrael with the Court of Appeals on August 30, 2023. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Derrick A. McIlwain with the Court of Appeals on August 24, 2023.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On October 3, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through October 31.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty (30) day extension from October 25, 2023 until November 24, 2023** in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
