Appellant's: (1) Supplement to her 20 October 2023 MOTIONS to Strike Respondent's Brief and the Clerk's 19 October 2023 Letter; AND (2) suggestion for an alternate solution.

Appellant Marie Assa'ad-Faltas, MD, MPH ("Dr. Faltas") *pro se* shows that this Court need only look to its own some-time multi-part opinions, the opinions of South Carolina's ("SC") Supreme Court ("SC S Ct") and/or the U.S. Supreme Court's ("SCOTUS") opinions, **to be satisfied that outline numbering is sequential numbering** with *all* readers understanding that; *e.g.*, III-A follows II-C. Dr. Faltas' numbering her Record on Appeal ("RoA") pages Vol III-p 1 *after* Vol I-p 96 **is thus rule-complying sequential numbering**. Nor was her choice of *sequential* numbering format whimsical. **Volume I contains the mandatory items in the descending chronological order mandated by Rule 210(c)**. The other volumes contain the exhibits and other evidentiary matter in *ascending* chronological order for ease of inferring causality.

Dr. Faltas also notes that in cases where a *supplemental* RoA is offered and accepted, there is no "deficiency" is starting it with "page 1" and citing to it as "Supp RoA, page x."

**It also impossible for Dr. Falta to renumber her RoA pages in unbroken Arabic numerals without knowing whether Volume II will be allowed to be filed or not.** What number would she assign to what is now Vol III – p 1? Page 97, assuming Volume II is disallowed? Or Page 111 assuming Volume II is allowed? Does she assume one, renumber 650+ pages, then have to go back and re-re-number them if she had guessed the fate of Volume II wrong?

Rather than make her thrice go through all that superfluous effort and expense, Dr. Faltas asks this Court to first Rule on allowing Volume II *as is vel non*, **then, if necessary for some mysterious reason to renumber everything** in *unbroken* Arabic numerals, to give her access *in the Court's publicly accessible location* to what is already filed and let her *manually* stamp every page with a mechanical manual stamp or hand-write Arabic numerals on every page in addition to the numbers-by-volume already automatically printed on every page and return the whole thing to the Clerk for the Clerk to rescan it, in however many sets the Clerk wishes.

To do otherwise is to impose on Dr. Faltas the burden and expense of *thrice* reprinting (and on the Court's staff the task of *thrice* scanning) 650+ pages when the first set of prints and scans is perfectly legible, intelligible and usable, as is.

Wherefore, the Clerk's 19 October 2023 letter should be struck, Respondent should not participate in oral argument and/or should pay the cost of this submission, and the timelines of this appeal should be suspended pending adjudication of this supplement and of the motion to file Volume II three business day late as so sincerely hereby sought on 27 October 2023.
