my motion. This also is coupled with my troubles gaining access to my legal files within the South Carolina Department of Corrections and my being without direction and a clear understanding of how to proceed due to all of these circumstances.

The South Carolina Department of Corrections uses an Automated Request To Staff Member (ARTSM) system in which prisoners must use to submit requests to SCDC staff. This digital, paperless, system prevents me from the ability to provide the proof as to the lack of access to my legal files. However, as I did not have a granted motion to proceed in *Ferna Payeris* - I was of the understanding / thought that I would then, if granted, need to share my troubles accessing my legal files if the SCDC haven't provided access by that time.

Secondly, since this Court's September 25, 2023, order was dismissed, I did not receive a copy of this dismissal until on October 20, 2023. However, on this same date - I also received an Order / Remittitur regarding the 2023-000948, lower case, dated October 17, 2023. This would prevent me from seeking a Petition for Rehearing in this Court (SC Supreme Court) for its dismissal of my case based on these irregularities.

Based on this, please do reconsider your dismissal
and please do ask that the South Carolina Court of Appeals
recall ^{rescind} its Remittitur.

Please note, on September 27, 2023, I was transferred
from MacDougall Correctional to Evans Correctional.

My current mailing address, above is ~~now~~ where the
Remittitur was mailed, while the previous address is
where your September 25, 2023 order was mailed.

I pray for your understanding in this regard. As an additional
issue on Petition for Certiorari Review I intend to question the dismissal ^{based} on ~~indigency~~
