MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Quinton Maurice Collins respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension** from November 6, 2023 until December 6, 2023, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Quinton Maurice Collins respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner and Appendix in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Thomas Griffin with the Supreme Court on October 23, 2023. Counsel attended the Annual South Carolina Public Defender Conference from October 9, 2023 until October 11, 2023. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of The State v. Anthony Markale Porterfield with the Supreme Court on September 25, 2023. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Shemual N. Yisrael with the Court of Appeals on August 30, 2023.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.






