**APPELLANT'S FINAL AND SUPERSEDING MOTION
FOR EXTENSION RE COMPUTER FAILURE FOR REPLY BRIEF**

Appellant has sent several previous communications to the Court regarding a computer failure Appellant suffered on November 1, 2023. Appellant was finally able to obtain a new computer on November 5, 2023. Appellant believed it would be a simple matter to “slave” the hard drive from the old computer to the new computer and pull the finalized Appellant’s Initial Reply Brief and a finalized motion seeking to strike parts of Respondent’s Initial Brief off of the damaged computer. Based on that, Appellant sought a short extension to November 6, 2023 and then to November 8, 2023. As explained herein, Appellant now needs an extension to **November 13, 2023** due to the nature of the computer failure.

Unfortunately, pulling data and files from the old computer has proven impossible, or at least beyond Appellant’s ability. Appellant has tried every method Appellant is aware of to “slave” the old hard drive to the new computer yet none have worked to allow Appellant to access the data and files on the old hard drive. As a result, Appellant has no choice but to re-prepare Appellant’s Initial Reply Brief and Appellant’s motion to strike from scratch. Appellant obviously remembers the material in both and will not need nearly the same amount of time to prepare them as initially, but it will take until **Monday, November 13, 2023** at the latest. Appellant accordingly seeks an extension of time to file Appellant’s Initial Reply Brief and Appellant’s motion to strike material in Respondent’s Initial Brief until **Monday, November 13, 2023**.

Appellant regrets asking the Court for additional extensions in this matter, but Appellant did not anticipate a computer failure, particularly not one that rendered Appellant’s data and files inaccessible. Appellant greatly appreciates the Court’s indulgence in this matter. Appellant will not ask for a further extension in this matter—if Appellant cannot file the Reply Brief and motion by November 13, 2023, Appellant will simply waive the right to do so.
