CHARLESTON, SC (WCSC) - Police are looking for a man they say entered the home of several College of Charleston students, stole several items and cooked himself a can of soup.

Herbert Alonzo Robinson, 46, is wanted by Charleston police for 1st degree burglary.

According to the police report, a man police believe to be Robinson entered on Oct. 14, a St. Philip Street home through the front door that had been left unlocked.

The victims reported they were sleeping at the time the man entered. He stole several DVDs, a bottle of vodka, a pink Dell laptop and a Sony PowerShot digital camera. The victims also found evidence the intruder used the bathroom - leaving behind a wash cloth covered in feces -- and ate a can of chicken soup he found in the cupboard.

5/26/11 I interviewed Lauren Rockman (victim) at the above address. Rockman stated that on the night in question she, Kathryn Jenkins, Amy Jackson and Michael Severino were asleep at the above address. Kimberly Casalvieri was not home that evening and no one was sleeping in her room that night. Rockman and Severino were the first to get up the following morning (can't recall the time). When Rockman got to the living room she noticed that her bag containing school items was missing and the school items were sprawled on the couch. Rockman did not pay much attention at first but then noticed a half empty can of soup on a table in the living room. Rockman also saw CD's missing from the bottom half of her DVD rack in the living room. Rockman woke up Jenkins and Jackson and checked Casalvieri's bedroom. Rockman called Casalvieri after noticing that her laptop was not in her room. Casalvieri told Rockman that she did

not have her laptop with her and her camera was hooked up to her laptop in her bedroom. Casalvieri came home before the police came. Rockman also found a solo cup full of liquor and liquor bottles in the kitchen that were opened. Rockman and her roommates did not touch the solo cup or the liquor bottles. When the police arrived they found fingerprints on the solo cup. Rockman's CD's were recovered outside on the sidewalk at the above address. Rockman denied knowing Herbert Robinson (client), Sheri or Randy. Rockman added that there was no party at her home on the evening in question where people were coming and going that she did not know. Rockman can't recall if she gave a statement to the police.
