ORDER

Appellant filed a notice of appeal, challenging a circuit court order dismissing her appeals of four writs of ejectment issued by a magistrate. After the parties filed their initial briefs, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss, arguing the appeal was moot because Appellant voluntarily vacated the property. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion to dismiss the appeal as moot. *See Sloan v. Dep't of Transp.*, 379 S.C. 160, 167, 666 S.E.2d 236, 240 (2008) (holding that generally, this court "will not pass on moot and academic questions or make an adjudication where there remains no actual controversy")
