

## ORDER

---

Appellant filed a notice of appeal from the circuit court's order denying his motion to preclude the release of his recorded communications being held and maintained by the Colleton County Detention Center. Appellant also filed a petition for a writ of supersedeas asking that this court "stay and quash" the circuit court's order. After careful consideration, we decline to quash the circuit court's order, but we temporarily stay the order to allow the interested parties to respond to Appellant's petition for a writ of supersedeas.

The State and the parties requesting access to Appellant's telephone calls may file a return to the request for a writ of supersedeas within fifteen days of the date of this order. Any potential amici curiae may file a brief(s) addressing the request for a writ of supersedeas within fifteen days of the date of this order. Thereafter, Appellant will have ten days to reply to any such return or amicus brief. In addition to any other arguments the parties or amici would like to make, we ask that they address section 30-4-40(a)(3) of the South Carolina Code (Supp. 2023).
