

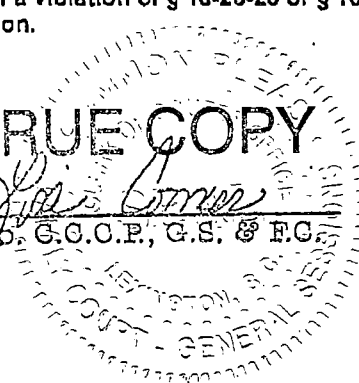

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on September 2023, the Grand Jurors of Lexington County present upon their oath:

That **Thomas Mckinley Carpenter** did in Lexington County, South Carolina on or about **June 27, 2023**, unlawfully cause physical harm or injury to a household member, namely **Bonnie Carpenter (AKA Bonnie Pilot)**; or offered or attempted to cause physical harm or injury to a household member with apparent present ability, under circumstances reasonably creating fear of imminent peril; and/or great bodily injury to a household member resulted or the act was accomplished by means likely to result in great bodily injury to a household member; and/or in the process of committing domestic violence in the second degree, the offense was committed in the presence of, or while being perceived by a minor in violation of Section 16-25-20 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976), as amended.
