Dear Ms. Hudson:

Please be advised that your motion to stay was received in our office on November 15, 2023. As of today's date, we have not yet received a Notice of Appeal from you.

According to Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), a Notice of Appeal must include the name of the court from which the appeal is taken; the judge's name; the lower court docket number; the date of the order being appealed; the name of the appealing party; and the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all the attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each. The Notice of Appeal should be substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. A copy of the order being challenged on appeal, proof of service showing the notice has been timely served on all respondents, and proof of filing a copy of your notice has been filed with the clerk of the lower court must accompany the Notice of Appeal.
