Here appellant seeks to appeal the Administrative Law Court order which affirmed the above mentioned SCDC disciplinary conviction. The Administrative Law Court (ALC) never served appellant with a notice of the right to appeal, much less to the South Carolina Court of Appeals. That said, Appellant did seek an appeal, albeit to the U.S. District Court and was only then told that an appeal should be made to the S.C. Court of Appeals long after the time to appeal had expired.

Appellant seeks to have the above mentioned disciplinary conviction overturned on grounds of due process violations where the disciplinary officer openly admitted that she did not and would not review appellant's primary evidence (video of the incident) and where certain witnesses were not present during the hearing where a verdict was entered.

Appellant takes this appeal pro se and in forma pauperis.
