

ORDER

Appellant filed a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. The right to proceed *in forma pauperis* must rest upon a statute or a fundamental constitutional right. *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). Appellant has the burden of showing his entitlement to this relief, but he has not done so. After careful consideration, Appellant's motion is denied.
