

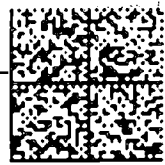

I don't think my PCR should be denied due to the fact that I was waiting on my lawyer because he promised to file an appeal for me on my voluntary manslaughter Afford Plea (I was told that it was me accepting a plea saying im not guilty and that's the only way I knew he was supposed to file the Appeal because he got the charge isolated) once I found out that wasn't the meaning I talked to another inmate (after I got tired of waiting for him and my mama telling me she wasn't getting no response) and he told me about an appeal and told me I had to file an PCR first and that my lawyer was lying (which I needed to file an PCR anyway due to me being miseducated and misguided). This was the end of September beginning of October and either way I was going to file my PCR before the deadline just in case I never hear from him. I give the inmate the information he needed then I happened to get move (including the address to the Orangeburg court house) and I didn't like the new unit they moved me to and went to lock up and got them to ship me to another yard because I couldn't go back to my old unit. When I got here I got the National Bar Association address which was in November and informed them of my situation (while I was in lockup) and asked for a PCR form. I waited and still didn't get a response. I asked an inmate how can I get an PCR form and he told me to write S.C. Supreme Court. My cousin that was in the unit with the inmate that wrote the PCR up for me called my mama and asked me what I wanted him to with it I told him to send it out for me. He called back and said he had to get it notarized and that I had to have somebody notarize it for me. I told him to send it to me and gave him my mama's address. She waited and it never came this was before I wrote the National Bar Association. My mama kept checking the mailbox and I went ahead and wrote the National Bar Association because I needed a PCR form and that my lawyer got me in prison under a false plea. It was before my one year deadline and I had enough time to get one and file it in time. When I finally wrote the Supreme Court and got one I put I turned in a hand written one because my mama said she never got it and I didn't hear from ~~my~~ my cousin and figured out that he got it send out him or the guy that wrote it ~~it~~

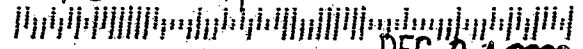
