I.

III.



However, the undersigned counsel has not yet been able to finish the Brief due to a heavy workload, other significant challenges that have resulted from substantial staffing issues that continue to be experienced by the undersigned counsel's office, and some unanticipated matters that have required the undersigned counsel's attention. Accordingly, in order to ensure the Brief is properly researched and prepared, I would therefore request an additional extension of time within which to serve and file the Brief.

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that the Court extend the deadline for the service and filing of the Initial Brief of Respondent and Designation of Matter in this case for thirty days from the date such relief is granted; hold the matter in abeyance pending a ruling on Respondent's motion; and grant such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.




