I.

II.

The Initial Brief of the Appellants, and the Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal, is due on August 1, 2013; however, the Appellants respectfully request that they be granted an extension of time to file their Initial Brief, and the Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal, in the event that, for some reason, or another, the Settlement is not consummated. However, the Appellants are reasonably confident that this Case will be resolved by Settlement. Nevertheless, in order to protect their Appeal, the Appellants respectfully request an Extension of time, of Thirty (30) Days, from August 1, 2013, within which time to File their Initial Brief and the Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal, in the event that the Case is not Settled.




