
Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, Respondent Sarah Filler (“Filler”) moves for an extension of time in which to serve and file Respondent’s Initial Brief (“Initial Brief”) and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal (“Designation of Matter”). Filler requests an extension of thirty days to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter which are currently due on December 6, 2023. This is the first request for an extension filed by Filler.

The grounds for this motion are that counsel for Filler was out of the office with an illness and other impending professional matters and obligations have created a need for additional time to prepare the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter.
